WTF judging rules will be used (40% Accuracy & 60% Presentation).

Protests

In the event of a protest, all complaints shall be directed to the chief referee. A protest form should be obtained and your written protest should be given to the chief referee along with a fixed fee of £50.00 within 10 minutes of the end of the match. If the protest is upheld, the fee paid will be refunded. No protests should take place on the ring itself.

Behaviour

The Nottingham Taekwondo Club is enforcing the BT no swearing policy. All coaches are to ensure that their club behaves in an appropriate manner. This includes parents' coaches' and players'. In the event of inappropriate / unacceptable behaviour the team concerned may be asked to leave the competition by the organiser without a refund.
